Eligibility	Eligible applicants are those that have 501c3 Non-profit status as described by the IRS and who operate in the Piedmont Region counties of: Alamance, Davidson, Forsyth, Guilford, Randolph and Rockingham. To be eligible for consideration, all prospective grant funded projects must have an LGBT component or serve the LGBT community in some capacity. Applicants must not have defaulted on a previously granted GGF Project Grant.

- Grant seeker agrees, as a condition to accepting any funds from the Guilford Green Foundation, that the Guilford Green Foundation may, in its sole discretion, make public the fact that its organization or institution is a grant recipient, the activities or purposes for which such grant is made, and the amount and manner in which any such funds would be used.
- Grant seeker authorizes any publicity or documentation that demonstrates a grantor-grantee relationship, should your organization or institution accept funds from the Guilford Green Foundation.
- Grant seeker agrees, as a condition to accepting any funds from the Guilford Green Foundation, that any funds granted by the Guilford Green Foundation be used solely and exclusively for the purpose, and within the time period, requested in this Grant Application, and that any differing use(s), or any use(s) within any differing time period(s), be pre-approved, in writing, by a vote of the Guilford Green Foundation Board of Directors.
